

Behavior Policy

Lincoln Library is committed to providing a safe and welcoming environment for all guests. Violations of these rules may result in being banned from library property, which includes both the library plaza and building.

1. Lincoln Library guests shall conform to all applicable federal, state, and local laws.
2. Guests under age 11 must be supervised at all times. Please refer to the Unattended Child Policy for more information.
3. All guests must be respectful of one another, volunteers, and library staff. Guests' behavior must not obstruct, threaten, harass or disturb fellow guests, volunteers, or staff.
4. Furnishings, materials, and equipment shall be used for their intended function. Prolonged or habitual sleeping is not allowed anywhere on library property.
5. Guests are responsible for personal items. Abandoned property will be confiscated. Large items, including bags, are prohibited on library property.
6. Improper use of restrooms is not permitted. This includes but is not limited to bathing, shaving, or laundering.
7. Drinks with lids are allowed inside the library, except for the computer areas. Food will only be permitted pursuant to the food policy, which is available upon request.
8. Guests shall dress appropriately and wear shoes at all times.
9. Photography or recording on library property is only allowed pursuant to the library's audio/visual policy, which is available upon request.
10. Only authorized service animals and program animals are allowed in the building.
11. Guests with a very strong scent may be asked to leave.
12. The consumption or possession of alcohol on library property is prohibited.
13. Weapons are prohibited on library property.
